

The e-Key is a non-physical authorization which contains the Case CATalyst options you are licensed to run and any expiration dates for these options. It is designed to protect the Case CATalyst license while empowering you to activate it on up to three computers.

Dongle Liberation!	An e-Key is an authorization to use Case CATalyst with an activation file rather than a security-device dongle. Case CATalyst 12 users with a security-device dongle can exchange it for an e-Key after receiving a Return Authorization (RA#) and temporary access code (TAC) from Stenograph. Exchanges will be made on a scheduled basis after the general release of Case CATalyst 12.
Mobile and Movable	Activate your CATalyst e-Key on up to three computers for your personal use. When you get a new computer, simply replace it as one of your three activations.
Safe and Secure	Since the e-key is non-tangible, it is impossible to lose it. Even if your Case CATalyst computer is stolen, you've haven't lost a security device per se. When you install CATalyst on another computer, simply activate it as one of your allowed activations.
Free and Fluid	The e-Key is standard with new Case CATalyst licenses beginning with Case CATalyst 12. Existing Case CATalyst users, who upgrade to Case CATalyst 12, can convert to an e-Key at no charge. Exchanges will be made on a scheduled basis after the general release of Case CATalyst 12.
You've gotta have It!	You must have Case CATalyst 12. To get Case CATalyst 12, you must have an active Support Agreement (except if you are a student with the CATalyst student edition) and reprogram your security device for Case Catalyst 12. <b>It isn't required that you keep an annual support agreement to keep your e-Key activated but it is recommended so you continue to get valuable updates and to keep in contact with Technical Support.</b>
D-I-Y . . . Self-Service	Activate your computers when it is convenient for you. It is available 24/7/365. You won't have to spend your time making a phone call for activation.
Get help from a "friend"	If your Case CATalyst computer doesn't have internet access, a manual activation process is available. You'll simply use another computer and carry the activation back and forth using a mobile medium, such as a USB thumb drive or a memory card.

Recurring Reminders	Thirty days prior to the end of your Activation period, Case CATalyst will prompt you to renew your e-Key activation. If you prefer to be reminded later, you can select the recurring period so that it won't pester you every day if you don't want it to.
Silent Activation	When the ninety-day activation period is ending, CATalyst will prompt you to activate. If you say yes, it will "silently" send an Activation Request via the internet to the Stenograph server and obtain Activation automatically. You don't have to enter your PKC code or do a thing other than say 'OK.'
Upgradeable	If you are using the student edition of Case CATalyst, for example, and are ready to upgrade to the professional version, your e-Key will be upgraded. Once you've made the purchase with Stenograph, your Activation will automatically be the professional version.
A long-term relationship	Once you have an e-Key from Stenograph, it will be yours for the foreseeable future. It is not required that you have an annual Support Agreement to get an e-Key or to keep it active.
Installment Eligible	Professionals and students, who have their Case CATalyst license through a quarterly installment program, are also eligible for the e-Key. No longer will you need to call your Stenograph sales representative to make payment and get another temporary access code. <u>No longer</u> will you be limited to using your CATalyst on one computer. When you activate quarterly via the internet you will be presented with a credit card payment screen to proceed. All done in one easy step when it is convenient for you.
CaseViewNet® and the e-Key	Case CATalyst users who are licensed for CaseViewNet will be pleased to learn that when they renew their CaseViewNet license, it will become part of their e-Key too. No longer will a CaseViewNet license be tied to a particular computer. Your CaseViewNet license will be a timed-option on your e-Key. Right along with your Case CATalyst, CaseViewNet will be activated on your computers for non-simultaneous use.
